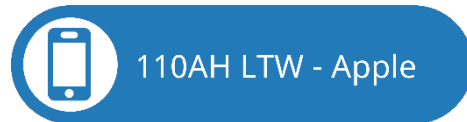

The QR code above will take you to the App Store where you just need to click 'GET' and the app will install. Go to the Connect section below for instructions on connecting to the battery.

Android

Scanning the QR code will take you to a file download for the .apk file for the battery monitoring app. There will be various warning because the app isn't coming from the Play Store. The App is safe.

The .apk file is the install file for the software. Your device will likely offer you an install option when you have downloaded this file. When you click install and accept installing apps from unknown sources it should install.

When the app installs, due to it being from an unknown source, it will install with the location permission blocked. You will need to go to your app setting and allow the App access to your location data, the 'Only while using the App' option is fine. Once you have opened the App and accepted the other permissions, move on to the connect section below.

Connect

When you open the App you should be on the connections page. Sometimes the App will open on the battery status screen, if it does then click the Bluetooth icon in the top left corner.

On the connections page you will have a Bluetooth icon at the top, if you click this the app will scan for your battery.

When the battery is found it will appear in the bottom list of 'Available Devices'.

If you click the battery you are trying to connect to in this list, it will start to create a Bluetooth pair.

When prompted for a password enter 6 ones '111111'.

Now the battery is paired with the app. On some devices the app will go straight to the battery status screen.

If you are not taken directly to the status screen. Click the battery in the paired devices section until it says connected just under the Bluetooth icon. Once it is displaying connected at the top;

Android, Clicking the phone's back button will take you to the battery status screen.

Apple, Swiping from the left of the screen towards the right will take you to the battery status screen.

If you have paired multiple batteries you will need to go back to the connections screen and click the battery you want to connect to in the paired devices list and again, once it's connected to the right battery, clicking back (Android) / Swiping to the right (Apple) will take you to the status screen.
